

### The Rules for attendance at Live Meetings (What is Expected)

- It is hoped that attendees have been double jabbed (unless exempt for health reasons)
  - If you are feeling unwell, please do not attend
  - If you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 please do not attend
  - You MUST wear a mask when in the hall (unless exempt) unless eating and drinking.
  - On entering the room, please sanitise your hands – sign in and pay your £3.00. Requests for tea/coffee can be made on the form provided at the desk when you sign in – you can bring your own flask if preferred.
  - Make your way to a seat which will be placed for social distancing; please do not stand around chatting.
  - Tea and coffee will be served at your seat in the interval; please remain in your seat during the interval. You can of course use the toilets, but it is your responsibility to wipe down any surfaces you have touched with the wipes provided.
  - At the end of the meeting, please wipe your chair and return it to the storage area and then leave the hall.

Doors and windows will be open, please bear this in mind as the weather becomes colder as we head into autumn/winter. You may like to bring a blanket.

The committee will continue to monitor and review the situation as we go through the season. In order that we have an enjoyable meeting we ask all members to follow these rules.
